<p>English</p> <p>We will be looking at heroes to begin the term; firstly Sir Roger Bannister. We will then write a report of our own sporting hero. Our comprehension skills will be improved through reading about a great variety of heroes (historical, musical and political).</p> <p>After SATS we will explore the heroes and villains of the Robin Hood stories.</p> <p>The class will continue to have weekly spelling tests and regular grammar sessions.</p> <p>We will link our poetry work to the theme of heroes and villains and use the power of imagery to write our own poems.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>There will be revision sessions for the year 6s in the run up to SATS. Year 5 (and after SATS year 6 also) will be improving their understanding of:</p> <p>The 4 Operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; mental and written methods. 2 and 3-place decimal numbers.</p> <p>Negative numbers. 2D and 3D shapes.</p> <p>Area, perimeter, volume and capacity.</p> <p>Equivalent fractions and percentages.</p> <p>Graphs: line.</p> <p>Timetables knowledge consolidation.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In our work on Light we will find out about sources of light, opaque, translucent and transparent materials, how we see things and look at how shadows are formed.</p> <p>We will also do some work on electricity, including drawing circuit diagrams, with symbols.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>We will use a comic making program to create our own comic.</p> <p>We will be reminding ourselves of internet safety.</p>	<p>Music/Singing</p> <p>We are looking at the work of Carole King and will listen and appraise various songs by her and learn to sing these. We will also try to accompany the songs using instruments.</p> <p>Festival of Voices songs.</p>
	<p>Opportunities for topic related Maths</p> <p>History focus: looking at how long ago various monarchs ruled and for how long. Getting a sense of generations ago (25 years).</p>	<p>Geography/History</p> <p>We will get to know the kings and queens of England from William the Conqueror to the present day. We will be then select two monarchs to investigate whether they were heroes or villains.</p>	<p>Art/DT</p> <p>Continuing our study of Pop Art we will look at the cartoon style of Roy Lichtenstein. We will do a comic-style painting.</p> <p>Later in the term we will have a heroes and villain theme DT project.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>We will learn about the key beliefs about God expressed by Muslims and Christians and will know the source of some of these beliefs.</p> <p>We will also explore different views of creation and consider the consequences of holding certain beliefs.</p>
		<p>PE</p> <p>Indoor PE sessions covering gymnastics, dance & fitness. Outdoor PE sessions extending skills and learning tactics and team working, - sessions led by trained PE coaches.</p> <p>Year 5 - Swimming</p>	<p>Languages</p> <p>We will continue to work on developing our French listening and speaking skills.</p>	<p>PSHCE</p> <p>We are thinking about 'what is special about me?' through our 'child of the week' session.</p> <p>We will be considering puberty (Yr 5) and healthy relationships (Yr6)</p>
