BBC Bitesize Daily which launched fun and exciting lessons for all ages from today (Monday 20th April).

Oak National Academy: From today, Monday 20th April, parents can access 180 lessons a week for every year group from Reception through to year 10, through a new online platform, Oak National Academy. The enterprise which has been set up by teachers and is funded by the Department of Education, will provide video lessons for students, with each lesson coming with a corresponding quiz and worksheet. Each lesson will last one hour and the portal will provide the equivalent of three hours of lessons a day for primary students and four hours for secondary.
