

Home Learning Guidance for Pupils from Monday 11th May

As the uncertainty around schools reopening continues, and as you reach the end of the second 'batch' of home learning activities, here is guidance for the following weeks.

Years 1 – 6 Each Day - Monday to Friday:

During the day at a time that fits in with your family, and your access to a computer, you should go on **BBC Bitesize daily** * and over the course of the day complete:

- The **daily maths lesson** for your year group
- The **daily English lesson** for your group

And, **optional**, the **one other subject lesson on BBC Bitesize daily** for your year group. BBC Bitesize is available for free on television (red button), online and through BBC iPlayer.

*Some families have said they prefer the National Oak Academy and that is fine, as long as you are doing one daily maths and one daily English lesson suitable for your age group.

In addition to these two lessons please make sure that you **read for between 20 minutes and 30 minutes each school day and keep a log of what you have read** (e.g. a list, notes in your reading record book or as a reading journal). Your teacher will be keen to see this when you are back in school.

Each week please spend the equivalent of **2 sessions of 40 minutes on 'other projects and learning ideas'** from previous Home Learning sheets. We know many of you are keeping diaries, making models, doing scrap book projects etc. Also your times tables and spelling practice.

There is **an expectation that children should be completing between 2 and 3 hours of home learning each day** but this may be in shorter chunks, and at any time of day that fits in with your family's pattern and around parents trying to work from home as well as other siblings' learning needs.

We encourage you to **share weekly one piece of work/photo/picture**, or a weekly diary record of what you have been doing, **with your class teachers by emailing them**, or by uploading to your google classroom account if you older children remember your log in details!
