

Class: Finches	Topic Title: Once Upon a Time			Term: Autumn 2020
<p>English Storytelling: The children will learn a range of different traditional fairy tales. Reading: We will be focusing on looking at fictional fairy tale books this term. The children will have the opportunity to read a wide range of different fairy tales. Writing: We will be discussing how we write a high five sentence (capital letters, finger spaces, punctuation, sound out carefully and read back to check) and then thinking about how we can extend our sentences using the conjunction 'and'. The children will have the opportunity to write in a variety of different styles, including letters, descriptive writing, retelling stories and a diary entry. Phonics: We are revising set 1 and 2 and then we will move on to learning set 3 sounds.</p>	<p>Maths In maths we will be focusing on place value to 20 and then numbers beyond 20, looking at how the numbers are ordered and one more and one less than a given number. We will be mentally adding and subtracting numbers to 20. We will be describing position and direction using common words and comparing lengths and heights. We will introduce the different values of monetary coins and notes.</p>	<p>Science In science we will be looking at the seasons of autumn and winter. We will talk about the weather in these seasons and how it changes between the two seasons. We will discuss what clothing we need to wear in each season and why. We will also look at how animals adapt to live in winter.</p>	<p>Computing We will be learning how to program a Bee-Bot to do what we want it to do. We will talk about what an algorithm is and why we need to be precise when we are writing one.</p>	<p>RE We will follow the Diocesan scheme of work, engaging and enquiring using key questions: Are religious celebrations important to people? Is God important to everyone?</p>
		<p>History In history we will be looking at how toys have changed over time. We will talk about toys now, in the early 20th Century and in Victorian times. We will compare them and talk about how they are similar and how they are different.</p>	<p>Art This term we are going to look at colour. We will learn what the primary colours are and then learn how to mix them into the secondary colours. We will look at and create artwork in the style of different artists including Piet Mondrian, Jackson Pollock and Robert Delaunay.</p>	<p>PSHCE We will be looking at what makes us individual and how we should have the confidence to be ourselves.</p>
	<p>Opportunities for topic related Maths Investigating questions such as: How long was Rapunzel's hair? How tall was the giant in Jack in the Beanstalk? How many bricks would you need to build a house for a pig?</p>	<p>PE The children have a weekly sports coach who teaches them the skills needed to be a successful sports person through fun and exciting games.</p>	<p>Languages We will be learning different ways to greet people around the world and then using them when taking the class register in the mornings and after lunch.</p>
