<p><b>English</b> Weekly spelling, guided reading, grammar and handwriting. Term 1. Novels of Dick King Smith. Writing biographies. Powerful writing techniques - simile, metaphor, alliteration, onomatopoeia and personification. Looking at different genres such as fables, myths and legends. Planning, writing and editing our own animal stories. Role play and drama. Term 2. The Animals of Farthing Wood book and magazine series and Charlotte's Web. Characterisation. Using a dictionary and thesaurus independently. Creating a class wildlife magazine. Non-fiction writing to contribute to individual animal books.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b> Number and place value. Mental and written addition, subtraction and multiplication. Learning times tables from 2x to 12x. Decimals, percentages, fractions. Weighing in grams and kilograms. Measuring capacity in litres and millilitres. Converting units. Symmetry and angles. Recognising shapes including types of triangle. Using timetables and recapping on telling the time. Solving word problems. Weekly investigation.</p>	<p><b>Science</b> Animals, Humans and Plants.</p> <p>What is a healthy diet? Planning our own healthy menus. Designing and making smoothies.</p> <p>How do our skeletons and muscles work? Importance of exercise. Recording our pulses before and after exercise.</p> <p>What is the function of each part of a plant? What part do flowers play in lifecycles?</p>	<p><b>Topic Related Learning</b></p> <p><b>Geography</b> Naming and locating countries and cities of the UK. Identifying and naming hills, mountains, coasts and rivers of the UK. Using the eight points of a compass and 4/6 figure grid references, symbols and keys on a map.</p> <p><b>Art/DT</b> Comparing the paintings of: Rousseau, Uccello and Stubbs. Focus on nature and the environment. Sewing felt and collage forest scenes. Designing and making bird food/bird feeders.</p> <p><b>French</b> Learning to describe people, places and objects in French. French town maps. Reading short sentences and picture books in French.</p> <p><b>RE</b> Special journeys and pilgrimages. Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam and Judaism.</p>
	<p><b>Opportunities for topic related Maths</b> The distance between cities of the UK. Working out grid references, lengths of rivers and population of cities.</p>	<p><b>PE</b> Basketball/Netball/Tennis. Skills and mini matches. Weekly swimming lessons.
