<p>English</p> <p>Storytelling We will be looking at a range of fiction stories relating to the questions that we are investigating, such as Michael Recycle.</p> <p>Reading The children will have the opportunity to read a range of stories and non-fiction books relating to the questions we are looking at.</p> <p>Writing The children will write in a variety of different styles including writing instructions, letters, non-fiction and reports.</p>	<p>Maths We will be consolidating understanding of 2-digit numbers and how to represent these in different ways. We will look at adding and subtracting a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number. We will investigate weight and capacity, comparing and measuring both. We will double and half numbers and shapes. We will revise the value of coins and telling the time. We will introduce multiplication and division.</p>	<p>Science In science this term we will be naming a variety of common wild and garden plants. We will look at the names for different parts of plants and trees. We will also be looking at what everyday objects are made of and describing the properties of materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock. We will carry out simple experiments such as growing seeds in different conditions to see what helps them to grow best.</p>	<p>Topic Related Learning This term we will look at, and discuss, artwork by Vincent Van Gogh and then create our own pieces in his style. We will also create artwork using colour to show emotions.</p> <p>In our geography lessons, we will look at where we live and why it is important to be able to recall our addresses. We will also look at the four countries of the United Kingdom and some of the main cities in each.</p> <p>In history we will look at some influential people, such as Marie Curie, and how they have helped us to have better lives. We will also look at how we have changed since we were born and create timelines to show this.</p> <p>In design and technology, we will be designing and making our own ice lollies, which we will evaluate when we have eaten them!</p> <p>In music, we will create music to show different emotions as well as following the Charanga scheme.</p>
<p>Phonics We will continue revising set 2 and 3 sounds together to help us to know when to use each grapheme.</p>	<p>Opportunities for topic related Maths We will investigate various topic related questions. How many miles does our food travel to get to us? How tall do sunflowers grow?</p>	<p>PE We will continue to have our two PE lessons a week with the PE coaches on Mondays and Wednesdays, where the children play a range of games to help to develop their sports skills.</p>	<p>RSE (Relationships and Sex Education) which includes over the primary years: Families and people who care for me, Caring friendships, Respectful relationships, Online relationships, Internet safety, Being safe, Mental wellbeing, Physical health and fitness, Healthy eating, Basic first aid, Changing adolescent body.</p> <p>In RSE we will talk about how to be a caring friend and healthy eating.</p>
