

Year Group: Owls	Topic Title: Amazing Authors - Anthony Browne			Term: Spring 2022
<p>English: As a class, and in groups in guided reading, explore the books of Anthony Browne. Focus on words and images, the themes, characters, settings, patterns, puzzles, connections and references.</p> <p>Write about characters in the stories, including Willy, who appears in several books. Write descriptions of settings. Write book reviews. Write comparisons of different books or versions of stories. Explore Anthony Browne's approach to retelling traditional tales such as Hansel and Gretel, Little Red Riding Hood, and Goldilocks, learn to tell a traditional tale and retell it and write it in own way. Continue developing interesting and varied sentences, using co-ordination and subordination.</p>	<p>Maths Place value and ordering 2-digit numbers; place value additions and subtractions; Rehearse complements to multiples of 10; find differences using a number line; find change from 10p and 20p, and from £10 to £20 by counting up and using bonds to 10 and 20; add two 2-digit numbers by counting on. Recognise and identify properties (including faces and vertices) of 3D shapes; sort according to properties including number of faces; name the 2D shapes of faces of 3D shapes; tell the time to the nearest quarter on analogue and digital clocks. Order 2-digit numbers and revise the < and > signs; locate 2-digit numbers on a landmarked line and grid; round 2-digit numbers to nearest 10; estimate a quantity <100 within a range. Revise doubles and corresponding halves to 15; find half of odd and even numbers to 30; Revise and recognise 1/2s, 1/4s, 1/3s and 2/3s of shapes; place 1/2s on a number line; count in 1/2s and 1/4s; understand and write mixed numbers. Count in 2s, 5s and 10s to solve multiplication problems and find specified multiples; x sign; record the 2, 5 and 10 times-tables; arrays.</p>	<p>Science Describe why exercise, a balanced diet and good hygiene are important for humans. What are the different types of teeth and parts of teeth? How should we care for our teeth? Identify and classify things. Ask simple scientific questions. What are insects? What are their characteristics? Identify different types. Why are they important?</p>	<p>Computing Use technology safely and responsibly e.g. using passwords and not sharing personal information online. Learn to use bookmarking so can find a safe site again.</p> <p>Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.</p>	<p>Music/Singing Learn and perform spring songs with Finches. Explore South African music using Charanga. Use the <i>BBC Ten Pieces</i> website to explore a range of classical and contemporary music.</p>
<p>Revise set 3 sounds in phonics sessions to support reading & spelling. Explore different spellings on Year 2 spelling lists. Learn how to answer reading comprehension questions. Improve speaking and listening. Learn to recite some poems by heart and perform them to class.</p>	<p>Opportunities for topic related Maths Size and weight of gorillas and chimpanzees. Cooking – weighing and measuring. Measuring while making worry dolls and as part of other DT projects. Putting Anthony Browne's books on a timeline. Make timelines.</p>	<p>Geography Use maps to locate where gorillas and chimpanzees live in the wild. Record locations on our own maps. Create keys to maps.</p> <p>PE Indoor PE sessions covering gymnastics, dance & fitness. Outdoor PE sessions extending skills and learning tactics and team working.</p>	<p>Art Use pastels (oil & dry), wax crayons & inks, watercolours, collage & poster paint. Look at Anthony Browne's different styles and techniques. Look at art which influenced him. Find out about Surrealist artists and games. Make surreal collages. Make observational drawings, including portraits.</p> <p>DT Make worry dolls inspired by Silly Billy. Make edible Easter lambs. Make healthy food: soup, bread and porridge.</p>	<p>RE Is it important to celebrate the New Year? Explore the ways that different people and different faiths celebrate New Year. Is Easter important for the church? Explore how the church celebrates Lent and Easter.</p> <p>PSHE/RSE Follow units: Relationships – Digital Wellbeing. Relationships – VIPS (very important persons). Discuss worrying, loneliness, isolation, bullying and friendship as explored in Anthony Browne's books.</p>
